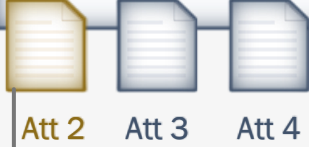


NNSA Stamps and Part Marking

Part Marking

NAP-401.1, Weapon Quality Policy



Part Marking is required to identify product and to control its use. Part Marking is specified by the DA within the product definition and applied to weapon and weapon-related product by the PA.

3.7 IDENTIFICATION, CONTROL, AND STATUS OF ITEMS

A process shall be established and documented so that items are identified and controlled to ensure proper use and maintained to prevent damage, loss, or deterioration.

FR75970 The DA must specify **part marking** requirements in the product definition.

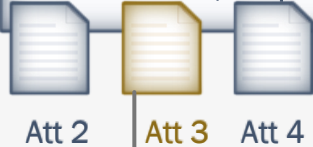

NNSA Stamps

NAP-401.1, Weapon Quality Policy










Product Stamping is applied to product to indicate that the product has been verified to be Mark Quality and has been NNSA Accepted. NNSA also uses NNSA stamps to indicate when WR product has been diverted to a Non-WR use. NNSA stamps are only applied by the NNSA Field Office or by the M&O WQA Team.

3.3 PRODUCT STAMPING

3.3.1 Purpose

This section defines the responsibilities and requirements for **NNSA stamping** of weapon and weapon-related products and packaging. The objectives of stamping product are to provide a visual indication of the quality status of the product, and to clearly differentiate between Mark Quality products that are ready for stockpile use (WR) and those that are not.
